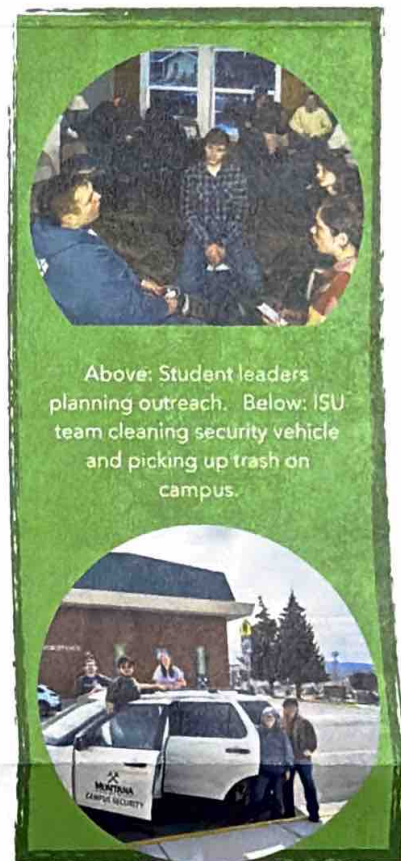

### “Foot washing and Following the Example of Jesus”

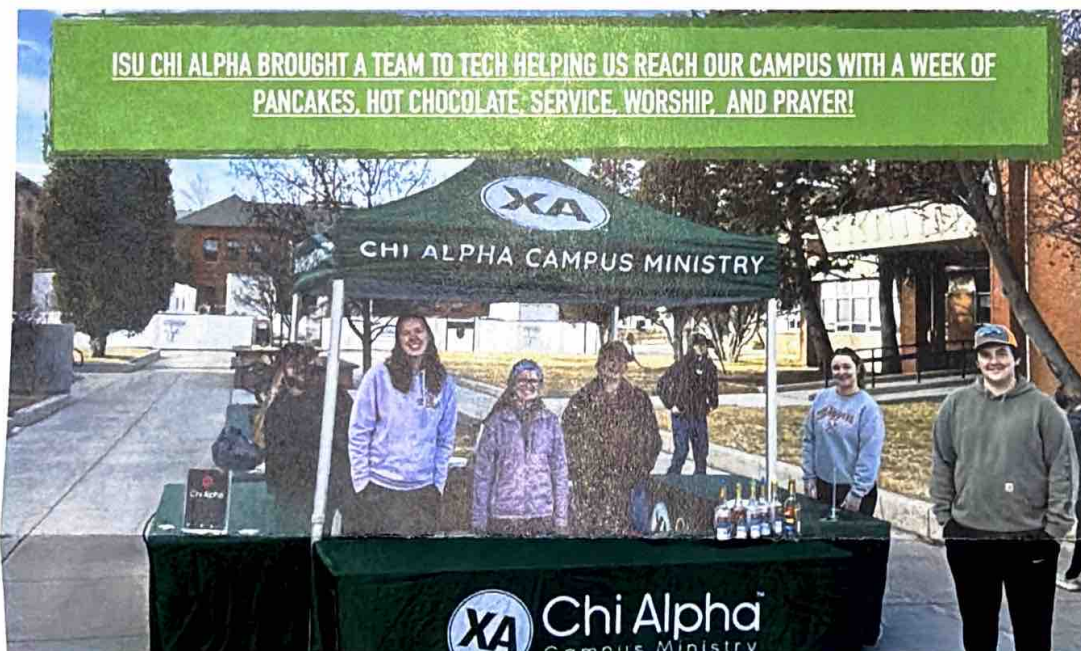
