



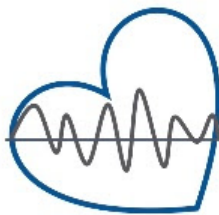

The last weekend in June, OMS celebrated the 125th anniversary its 1901 founding.

June was a busy month in the life of OMS celebrating the past and looking to the future of

the organization. This year, annual missionary council meetings dovetailed into anniversary celebrations which brought over 500 missionaries, supporters, and ministry partners to Indianapolis in one big weekend event.

The focus of the week long meetings and events was "Faithful God, Faithful People, Unfinished Task." It was a special time of reflecting on the rich and blessed history of OMS. In addition, we embraced the task before us of increasing our impact through the Engage 2033 initiative, which focuses on Believers, Bibles, Bodies of Christ, and Bridges to Mission. The Engage 2033 initiative is not a new approach to ministry at OMS, but rather, is an intentional focus on sharpening what we already do in the areas of multiplying disciples, churches, leaders and missionaries.
